- Outreach Services
- Case Management Services
- Assistance in Obtaining and Coordinating Public Benefits Available
- Education regarding life skills, budgeting, maintaining sobriety, etc.

Please attach the following **required** eligibility documentations:

- Documentation of disability (substance use diagnosis)** - from a psychiatrist, doctor, counselor, PO, etc.
- Housing status (preference given to those who are homeless, i.e. in a shelter or living in a place not meant for human inhabitation, at the time of selection)
